Due to this commitment, the Oconomowoc Lions Club has created a scholarship for the students of Oconomowoc High School.

Scholarship Overview:

The Oconomowoc Lions Club Scholarship was established to support graduating seniors who exhibit a commitment to serve others and strive to further their education after high school. Two graduating seniors from Oconomowoc High School will receive a **\$1,000** scholarship to help defray the cost of their higher education expenses. One scholarship will be awarded to a student attending a Four-year college and the other to a student attending a Vocational/Technical and Career college. The scholarships are designed to reward a commitment to service, therefore the community service component is heavily weighted.

Scholarship Eligibility:

To be considered for an Educational Scholarship, an individual must be an Oconomowoc High School graduating senior, and must have applied or been accepted for enrollment at an accredited institution of higher learning. You are not eligible if your parent/guardian is a member of the Oconomowoc Lions Club.

- List any awards, achievements, accomplishments, sports activities, clubs, or positions held during high school years.
